News from the Complex

This winter the Toca Soccer Complex has continued to develop. We have been blessed to have been able to add three new advisers to the board leading the construction project and we are so grateful for the experience and expertise they bring to the table. They will be key to bringing the changes you will be seeing in the next year. Thank you to Fernando Plastino, Federico Olivera and Veronica Requena!

Construction of Phase 2 continues and the next step is the completion of two new wells. These wells have been drilled and cased and we will be bringing electricity to the well site and installing pumps, pressurizing tanks and a 2,500 gallon cistern in the next few weeks. Finally pipes must be laid to the fields and hydrants installed for connecting the hoses. This will be key to seeding the new field and keeping our existing field green.

Construction of the new field continues and plans are being developed for Sul's Pavillion, which will accompany the new field. In addition, preliminary construction is underway to remodel the house on the site in order to allow for an indoor bathroom, locker room and multipurpose room, and an outdoor patio area! We are also working on developing a new Teqball/Beach Soccer court, as Toca has received two brand new outdoor professional

quality Teqball tables from the National Federation for Teqball. This is a new and challenging sport which will be a fun way for smaller numbers of players to practice some crazy soccer foot skills and ball control.
